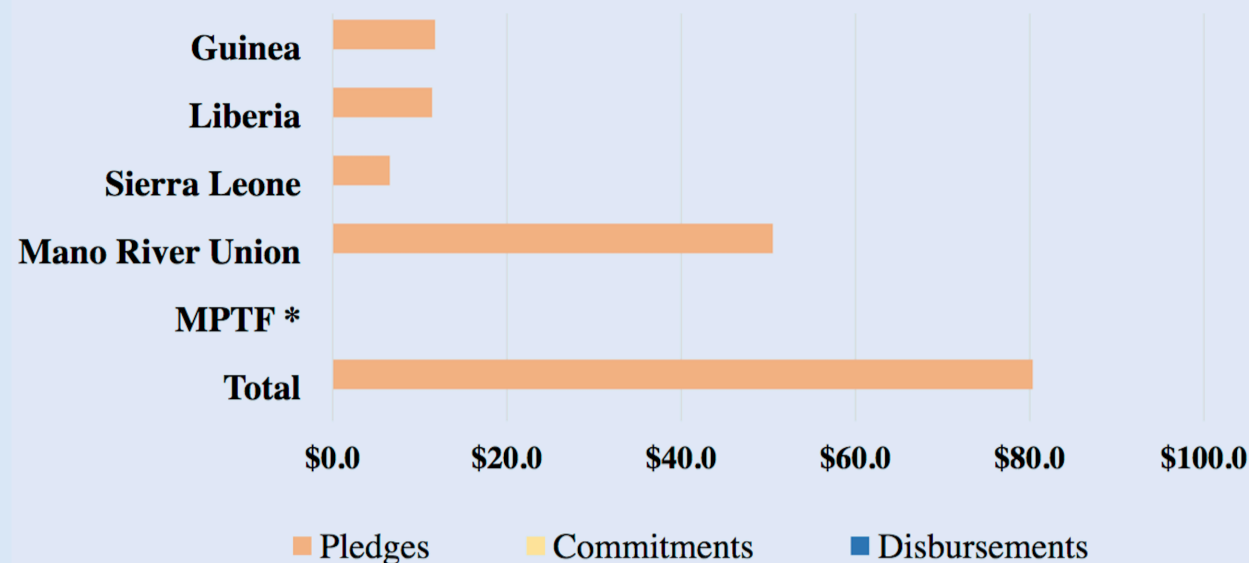

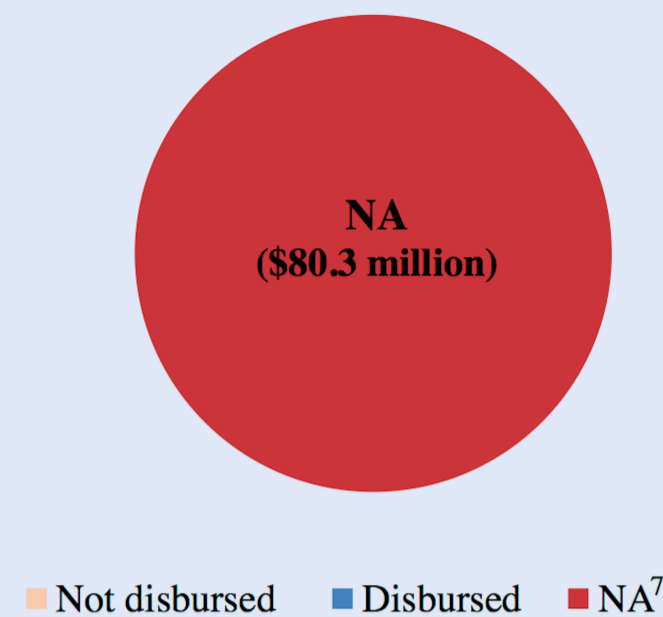

2. Prior to the July 2015 International Ebola Recovery Conference, Japan indicated a total of \$184.9 million in Ebola-related funding, including \$30.8 million to Guinea; \$24.2 million to Liberia; \$24 million to Sierra Leone; and \$105.9 million to cross-regional programs.

3. Out of a total of \$80.3 million pledged, \$68.6 million (85.4%) includes funds reprogrammed from multi-year development programs.

4. Japan's "priority sectors" include: 1) essential health services; 2) health workforce; and 3) epidemic preparedness and response.
