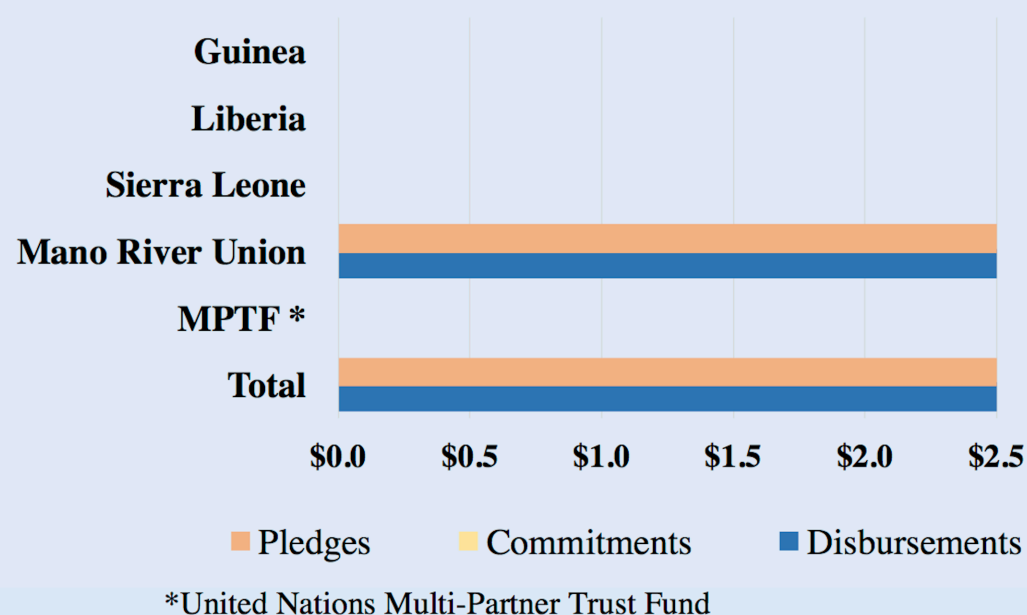

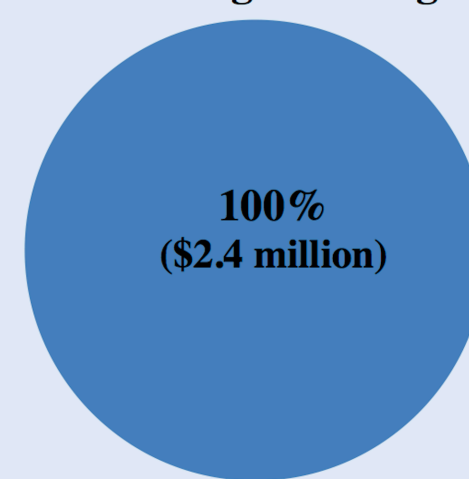

2. Prior to the July 2015 International Ebola Recovery Conference, the Netherlands indicated \$5.5 million in Ebola-related contributions to the “Ebola Recovery and Reconstruction Trust Fund” of the World Bank.

3. The \$2.4 million disbursed by the Netherlands was invested in a collaboration between the Netherlands, Ghana, Guinea, Rwanda, and Sierra Leone in an effort to establish a robust preparedness system. The Dutch Royal Institute for the Tropics, together with the University of Amsterdam, developed a program in collaboration with research partners in Ghana (Noguchi Memorial Institute for Medical Research), Sierra Leone (Njala University, Department of Community Health Science and Department of Agricultural Science), Rwanda (Health Development and Performance), and Guinea (Sonfonia University).
