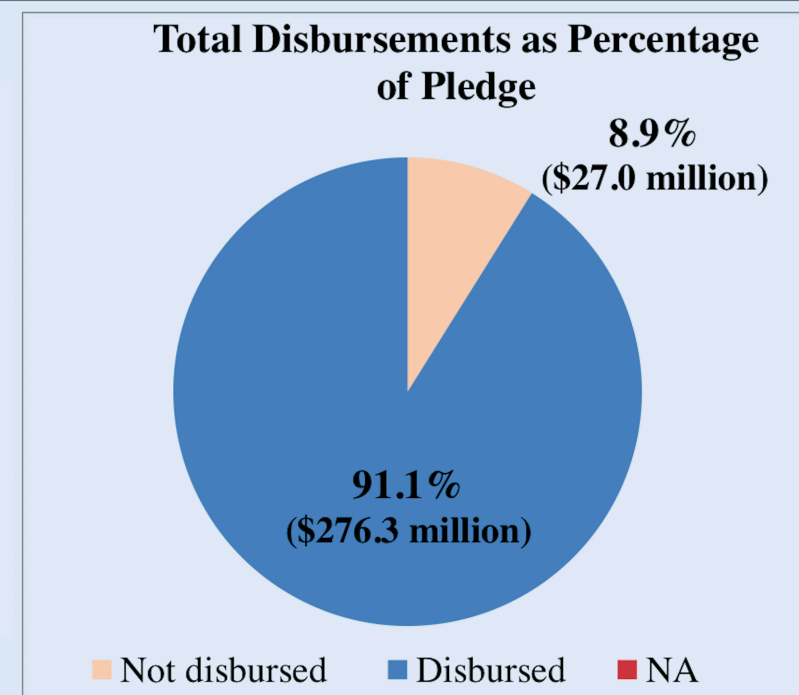

1. All exchange rates use the Operational Rates of Exchange of the United Nations Treasury as of October 15, 2016. At the July 2015 International Ebola Recovery Conference, the United Kingdom pledged a total of £248.65 million including £8.65 million for Liberia and £240.0 million for Sierra Leone. In US dollars, this amounted to a total pledge of \$391.57 million including \$13.62 million for Liberia and \$377.95 million for Sierra Leone using the June 30, 2015 United Nations Operational Exchange Rate, the most current rate available at the time of the conference.

2. Prior to the July 2015 International Ebola Recovery Conference, the United Kingdom indicated \$65.8 million in Ebola-related contributions for Sierra Leone.

3. Pledges and commitments for Liberia will support the Health Sector Pool Fund which helps to finance priority unfunded needs within the National Health Plan of Liberia and is managed by the Government through the Ministry of Health. Out of \$5.1 million disbursed by the United Kingdom to Liberia, \$5.1 million (100%) was disbursed to Health Sector Pool Fund.

4. Out of the \$292.7 million pledged toward Sierra Leone at the time of the 2015 International Ebola Recovery Conference, \$176.8 million (60.4%) is earmarked for economic development and tax revenue, and \$115.9 (39.6%) for basic services including health, education, and water, sanitation, and hygiene.
