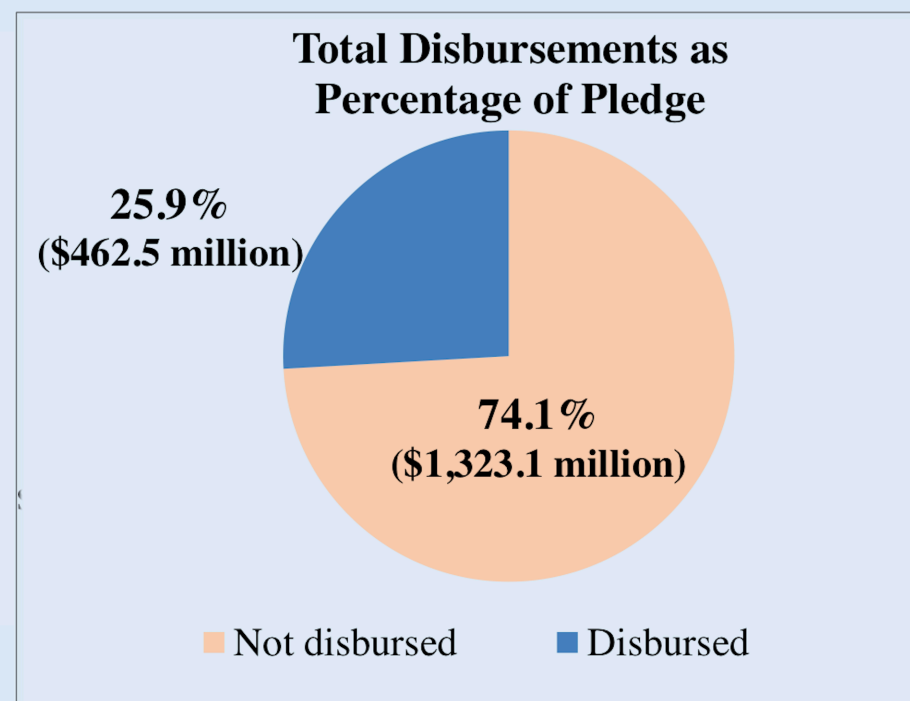

3. Out of \$462.5 million disbursed by the World Bank, \$360.5 million (77.9%) was disbursed to governments (excluding budget support); and \$102 million (22.1%) to treasuries (budget support).

4. The World Bank's disbursement went 100 percent toward treasury and government entities in each of the affected countries. Of the total disbursement of \$462.5 million to the governments of Guinea, Liberia and Sierra Leone, \$193.2 million was then channeled from the affected governments to United Nations funds and programmes. This included \$61.6 million from Government of Guinea, \$71.4 million from the Government of Liberia and \$60.2 million from the Government of Sierra Leone.
