(2) This analysis is based on data received from the top 12 donors in December 2012. It was converted using UN exchange rates from December 2012.

(3) The IMF disbursed \$111.1 million (SDR 73 million) as a new loan to Haiti post-earthquake. The debt on this loan was cancelled as part of the debt relief (totaling \$270.9 million or SDR 178 million) executed in November 2010. These resources will be used in support of the Government of Haiti's economic recovery in future years.
