(2) The IMF disbursed \$116.8 million (SDR 73 million) as a new loan to Haiti post-earthquake. The debt on this loan was cancelled as part of the debt relief (totaling \$285 million or SDR 178 million) executed in November 2010 and has now been classified as other funding. These resources will be used in support of the Government of Haiti's economic recovery in 2011 and over future years. Approximately \$68.4 million has been allocated to the Haitian budget for the fiscal year beginning 1 October 2010.
